Section	Extract from full text
52	<p>Every sanitary authority may, and when required by order of the Local Government Board shall, themselves undertake or contract for [...] the removal of house refuse from premises.</p> <p>All matters collected by the sanitary authority or contractor in pursuance of this section may be sold or otherwise disposed of [...]</p>
53	<p>If a sanitary authority who have themselves undertaken or contracted for the removal of house refuse from premises [...] after notice in writing from the occupier of any house within their district requiring them to remove any house refuse, to cause the same to be removed or cleansed, as the case may be, within seven days, the sanitary authority shall be liable to pay to the occupier of such house a penalty not exceeding five shillings for every day during which such default continues [...].</p>
54	<p>Where the sanitary authority do not themselves undertake or contract for [...] the removal of house refuse from any premises [...] they may make byelaws imposing the duty of such cleansing [...], at such intervals as they think fit, on the occupier of any such premises.</p>
